

Pacific Yew

Pacific Yew is actually a softer wood that has coloring ranging from pink to amber which continue to develop as the wood ages.

Coloring

Sapwood is usually a thin band of pale yellow or tan color, while the heartwood is an orangish brown, sometimes with a darker brown or purplish hue. Color tends to darken with age.



Grain & Texture

Grain is straight, with a fine uniform texture. Good natural luster.
